


Healing Prayer has Been Part of the Judeo-Christian Tradition From Its Beginnings

1 Samuel 16:13





How Do I Get Healing Prayer at SJNP?




After you receive communion, make your way into the small lobby to the right of the Altar – the lobby area is referred to as the Healing Prayer Chapel






- ❖You may kneel or stand. You need not say anything, but you can ask for prayers on your or anyone's behalf.
- ❖ Prayer minister offers one of 3 very brief prayers while placing their hands on your shoulders and head and then also makes a small sign of the cross with oil on your forehead.
- Afterwards, simply return to your pew in church.





Feel free to light a votive candle if you wish





Confidentiality

- Who came for prayer & what was shared (if anything) is not spoken of or shared with anyone
- Exception a personal crisis that is serious enough to cause alarm – we pass that on to Clergy for consideration for pastoral care
- We do not later approach a prayer recipient -- they can approach us. A close friend, maybe, but the primary rule is it all stays in the Healing Prayer Chapel
